a. Fluoridone Treatment Update	Initial full lake treatment was applied on Monday, October 2, 2023.

i. Fundraising	<ul> <li>We met and exceeded our goal of \$20K! In total we raised \$21, 590.89, in addition to the incoming DNR grant of \$1,500. Awesome work, everyone!!</li> <li>Discussed donation levels and recognition. Paul N. will cover the cost of recognition items with personal funds. The recognition plaque is in process, with Platinum level donors' business names slated to be listed on the installation. A few private donors contributed at this level but have opted to remain anonymous and/or not be listed on the plaque. ACTION ITEM: Joyce &amp; Leigh will follow up with the creation and installation-related tasks.</li> </ul>
ii. Timing/Details	<ul> <li>A full-lake treatment was applied on Monday, October 2, 2023. The process took approx. 3-4 hours and went smoothly.</li> <li>Treatments should make a visual impact on the lake by Spring 2024.</li> <li>After this initial treatment, another bump will occur in November 2023, followed by a third bump treatment in Spring 2024. At that time, treatment should last 2-3 years with only bump treatments expected to be needed moving forward to control the invasive milfoil species.</li> <li>Amber is contacting SePRO to coordinate sampling schedule to determine ppb throughout the coming year.</li> </ul>
iii. Questions	<ul> <li>ACTION ITEM: Paul – Take pictures with Rick's drone.</li> <li>Question re: monitoring boats coming into the lake to prevent contamination.</li> <li>Is Maplewood planning to assist in maintaining boat launch area?</li> <li>Will this treatment impact lily pads? Answer – no, but onshore treatment is an option for lakefront owners.</li> </ul>
