Currently, Silver Lake is free of them, unlike all other lakes in the VBWD.</li> <li>Zebra mussels have been detected in a number of water bodies near Silver Lake, including Long Lake, Lake DeMontreville, Lake Olson, Lake Jane, and Lake Elmo, White Bear Lake, and McCarrons Lake.</li> <li>2025 monitoring did not detect Zebra mussels in Silver Lake, which means it's imperative we do what we can to prevent the spread of Zebra mussels into Silver Lake.</li> <li>Most importantly any boats or recreational equipment that moves from an infested water body into ours could cause an infestation.</li> <li>Action Item: Contact Meg re: issuing statement to city contacts re: zebra mussels.</li> <li>Action Item: Draft/send email to SLIA mailing list to remind residents to thoroughly clean off boats, explain zebra mussel situation, emphasize that Silver Lake does not have them yet.</li> </ul>
